Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine store employing only four individuals. Overall sales for that initial year amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and other components. During five years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 employees and their annual sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is among the leading international producers in the material handling industry.

Production and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business possibilities. Over the past sixty years, the material handling industry has grown into a very advanced area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this progress. Cascade at present continues to develop as the best provider of lift truck attachments and various associated items. The business feels confident in their potential so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive within the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, fabricating and advertising hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was finished in 1956 on a brand new office in order to accommodate all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. Following fifteen years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached nearly 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Stockton a second manufacturing facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry while the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the U.S. with locations in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Stockton. Cascade products are made worldwide thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of five companies, along with the global best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
