

Grapples for Forklifts

Forklift Grapple - Grapples work together with the crowning operation of the bucket cylinder located on the excavator. They could mount directly onto the jib or whatever quick hitch which is in bucket position. Grapples are most often used for the processing and handling of timber, construction materials, domestic and aggregate waste items. The grapple's boxed design has additional support bridging. This manufactured design provides the grapple with maximum strength and support by means of stopping the body from breaking and twisting through its function.

The grapple and all of its moving parts are made out of hardened steel. The pivot points are designed to be able to ensure holding ability and supreme closing force. The one operating it has the capacity to handle all sizes and varieties of supplies using the jaws built-in at the end of the grapple with toes. This could enable the jaws to be able to close through one another in a finger configuration for utmost handling capacity.
