

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is about 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted forks differ by the amount of offset between the blade and the blade eye. Various makers will differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
